
Sisterhood

Sisterhood's annual meeting was held on Wednesday, July 28, 2010. Salessa Berk, Membership Vice-President, reported that we have 100 paid members including 37 Life members. JoAnn Dempler's Treasurer's report showed that Sisterhood's main sources of revenue this year were from our membership dues, investments, Hanukkah dinner, bake sale, donations, Onegs/Kiddushes, and our calendar. Sisterhood's responsibilities include all kitchen expenses, office supplies, copier expenses, bonuses, and gifts. We are also a financial resource for the Temple when needed.

We reviewed the costs for Onegs and Kiddushes which are as follows: When Sisterhood is catering an Oneg, the cost is \$40 for a Friday night Oneg and \$50 for a Saturday morning Kiddush. The cost for members supplying their own baked goods is \$20 for an Oneg and \$25 for a Kiddush. All checks are to be made out to *TBI Sisterhood* and sent to JoAnn Dempler, not to the Temple office. Sisterhood members have signed up to be "Hostesses" for several of the months throughout the year, however we still need additional hostesses. These women will be contacting you to sponsor an Oneg or Kiddush for a yearzeit or a celebration. We would appreciate your support.

We are planning our annual Membership Luncheon for either October 17th or 24th. Additional information will be in next month's Temple Talk. This year's Hanukkah Dinner will be held on Sunday, December 5th. Please mark your calendars!
